

URO Annual Report

The University Research Office (URO) highlights of accomplishments for 2017 involves the creation of the Food Innovation Center, University Statistical Research Center, also, researches on Solar-Powered Generator passed the pilot testing of DOST as it produced enough power to run common household appliances simultaneously. The successful International Research Conference held at the Princesa Garden Resort, Palawan on December 18-20 was also one of the major achievement of the University Research Office.

With respect of its core function which is to oversee the conduct of research activities as to consolidate, coordinate and operationalize research activities, the URO was able to obtain 34 completed researches; 14 published researches internationally, 7 published researches in CHED accredited journals; and 6 externally funded researches. Moreover, 22 researches were presented 26 international. In addition, the Office conducted 2 In-House Reviews for Completed Researches and 5 Capability Building Seminars.
